BEHAVIORAL AGREEMENT

Dear Parents,

The apostle Paul, in his second letter to the young pastor Timothy, paints a very vivid picture of mankind in the last days. One has only to look at the front page of any newspaper to realize just how accurate was his Spirit-led insight. Truly we live in dark times, yet that serves to make the light of the gospel shine brighter. While French Creek Bible Conference Association continues to facilitate the training and growth of our covenant young people, we strive to protect them physically as well as spiritually. For that reason, we have taken a close look at the rules structure of our conferences, and we have revised them to continue to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the campers in light of the situations which exists in the world around us. We ask that you carefully and prayerfully consider the role which you play in this undertaking, and that you work with us to keep French Creek a place of learning and growth, and one of safety from this present evil age.

CHRISTIAN STANDARDS OF CONDUCT, AS OUTLINED IN THE INFALLIBLE WORD OF GOD, are expected throughout the entire slate of conferences. Furthermore, please be advised that the administrative rules and regulations promulgated specifically for the conferences and approved by the Board of Trustees of the French Creek Bible Conference Association are also in effect at all times throughout the conference as a concern for the health, safety and welfare of the campers. Please review with your child the rules and regulations listed below and on the reverse. If you have any questions or concerns regarding this document, please first contact the director of the appropriate conference and then the Board of Trustees for further information and/or direction.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE FRENCH CREEK BIBLE CONFERENCES

1. Campers may not participate in any act which is in violation of state park rules, local ordinance, or state or federal law.
2. Campers are not permitted to use any tobacco product (e.g. cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, etc.) for the duration of the conferences.
3. Campers may not be in possession of nor use alcohol or other drugs (or anything else intoxicating) at any time. If a camper should require doses of a doctor-prescribed medication during the conference, the parent should make arrangements with the conference director to provide the conference nurse (upon arrival at the conferences) with the medication (in its original container) and directions for its use.
4. Campers may not be in possession of any kind of weapon or dangerous device. A weapon or dangerous device is defined as any tool, instrument or implement capable of inflicting bodily harm, including (but not limited to): any knife, firearm, shotgun, rifle, fireworks, chemical spray, or any other household object which serves no legitimate purpose at the conference.
5. Campers may not use nor be in possession of any pornographic materials.
6. Clothing must reflect Christian standards of decency and modesty, and must not be inappropriate or distracting to the spiritual environment of the conference. Clothing should also be appropriate for a group camp environment.
 - Clothing styles which inherently may be considered revealing or immodest will not be permitted.
 - Clothing which is worn in an inappropriate or revealing manner will not be permitted.
 - Clothing (including accessories) which is imprinted with anything that may be considered disrespectful or inappropriate for a Bible conference will not be permitted.
 - Final decision on the appropriateness of dress rests with the conference director.
7. Campers are expected to follow the conference schedule and be on time for all activities unless excused by the nurse or conference director.
8. Campers are expected to keep in touch with their counselor and to follow all direct and reasonable requests which may be given by the adults in charge.
9. Campers are expected to remain on the conference grounds at all times unless participating in a supervised scheduled activity, or unless permission is granted by the conference director.
10. Campers are not permitted to visit the cabins of members of the opposite sex, nor visit the cabins in any other unit. The practice of raiding cabins is prohibited.
11. Campers may participate in water activities only at scheduled times. In addition, campers are expected to observe all rules posted by the pool management.
12. Campers must observe the established curfew – “Taps” means lights out and quiet.
13. Campers are expected to assist in duties (e.g. table setting, cleaning the buildings and grounds) which ensure an orderly and efficient conference.
14. Campers must take care of and protect the plant and animal life, grounds and park property.
15. Campers may not bring portable electronic devices, comic books or water balloons to the conference.
16. Campers must observe Sunday as a Sabbath to the Lord. There will be no recreation nor sales on the Sabbath day. There will be appropriate planned activities on Sunday afternoon.
17. Couples must refrain from inappropriate public displays of affection, and must remain with the group at all times.

Any infraction (depending on the degree of severity and/or the chronic nature of the offense) can result in disciplinary action as follows:

1. Restriction of privileges (e.g. cabin restriction, work detail, etc.) or any other reasonable consequence as determined by the conference director.
2. Parental notification.
3. Return of camper to his/her home via parent-provided transportation, with no refund of fees.

NOTE: Any camper sent home for disciplinary reasons from one conference may not return to any age-appropriate conference for the duration of that year's conference schedule. In addition, any camper sent home from a conference for disciplinary reasons may not attend another conference in any capacity in a subsequent calendar year without a written recommendation from his/her Session.
